- Item 93.3: Criterion I Curricular Aspects
 - Programmes/ courses focused on employability/ entrepreneurship/ skill development
 - 116 courses focusing on employability / skill development were introduced during January 2019 to March 2019. The details are given as Annexure I.
 - It was informed by Dean (Academic) that 59 new courses were introduced during January 2019 to March 2019. The details are given as Annexure II.
 - The Criterion Convenor presented the details of the new value-added courses.

- The MOOC courses were opted by the students during 2018 19 even semester. The details of total of 17 MOOC courses selected by 135 students were presented.
- The feedback on curricular aspects gathered from the Alumni during the Convocation 2018 was analysed and the report was presented by the Criterion Convenor Dr.P.K.Srividhya, Dean Academics in the 92nd IQAC meeting. The same was approved for uploading in the website. The weblink of the same was displayed during the 93rd IQAC meeting.
- In the academic year 2018-19, 237 students have completed 539 online MOOC courses offered by Udemy.

• Dr.S.Margret Anouncia, Alumni suggested that additional support must be provided to slow learners by assigning teaching staff to the slow learners after the teaching hours.

Item 93.4: Criterion II - Teaching Learning and Evaluation

- The Criterion Convenor Dr. K. Lakshmi presented the details of full time teachers who received awards, recognition, fellowships at State, National, International level from Government, recognized bodies. The details are given as Annexure III.
- Questionnaire for Student satisfaction survey regarding teaching learning was submitted for review and approval. The same was approved. The questionnaire is provided as Annexure – IV.
- Dr.S.Margret Anouncia, Alumni suggested to collect feedback on assessment from the students for analysis.

Item 93.5: Criterion III - Research, Consultancy and Extension

- Dr. S. Kumaran, Dean / Research briefed the research activities of PMIST in the last three quarters (April June 2018, July Sept 2018, Oct Dec 2018) in addition to the present quarter (Jan March 2019). He highlighted the five International Conferences organised simultaneously by various departments on 12th and 13th March 2019. He also briefed the Lectures delivered by the three members team from University of Iowa, USA, Prof. Eric Hoffman, Dr.Alejandro Pierre Commellas Freymond, Dr. Emma Stapleton, Dr. Kizhakke Puliyakote and Abhilash Srikumar from University of California, interacted with students and faculty on 28th & 29th January 2019.
- Dean Research narrated about the outcome of Vice Chancellors' meeting with Internal Research Scholars (PMIST Faculty who are pursuing Ph.D in part-time mode) held on 27th March 2019. It was

emphasized that the research scholars who have completed their research should try to submit their Ph.D theses before December 2019.

- Dr.S.Margret Anouncia, suggested that the workload of the faculty can be reduced or they can be totally relieved for one semester for allowing them to write the thesis. If not completed, the workload should be increased doubly in the consecutive semesters.
- It was also suggested that if the research scholars (Internal & External) fail to submit the progress reports consecutively thrice, the respective Research Supervisors and HoD shall be held responsible for the same.
- Workshops/Seminars conducted on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and Industry-Academia Innovative practices during January 2019 to March 2019 were presented. The details attached as Annexure – V.
- Awards for Innovation won by Institution/Teachers/Research scholars/Students received during January 2019 to March 2019 were presented.

- No. of books purchased were 76 in July to Sept 2018, 34 in Oct to Dec 2018 and 1210 in Jan to March 2019.
- Revenue generated by PROBE was Rs. 4,47,780/- in July to Sept 2018, Rs. 4,76,472/- in Oct to Dec 2018 and Rs. 4,32,252/- in Jan to March 2019.
- Comparative Statement of Staff and Student User Report of the Library for July to Sept 2018, Oct to Dec 2018 and Jan to March 2019 was discussed.
- Mr. V.Anburaj, Representing Board of Management suggested to included the Department Library usage, Book Borrowers and Reference book users also in Library Usage Report.
- He also suggested to appreciate the Faculty and Students for Highest Library Usage every month.
- Prof.S.A.Dhanaraj, Registrar suggested to reduce the book lending period to 15 days instead of 6 months.
- Dr. Senthamil Kumar highlighted about the 25th Library Committee meeting held on 4th March 2019.

 Mr. V.Anburaj, Representing Board of Management suggested to enclose the minutes of the meeting or highlight a few major points discussed during the meeting.

He also highlighted various programmes organised by Centre for Students and Administrative Services (CSAS) for the staff and students during the previous quarters and their outcomes.
- He has also presented the details of students appeared and qualified in competitive and other external exams.
- Ms. Hemanisha of ECE has been appointed as Assistant Engineer (AE) in Chennai Metro and Ms. Shaghitha Parveen of ECE as Deputy Collector
- Measures taken for organizing Department Alumni meet in the next quarter (April June 2019) by various departments was presented.
- He submitted a comparative report (April 2018 to March 2019) of programmes organized by Centre for Students and Administrative Services (CSAS) in the previous quarters. It was highlighted that totally 22 programmes were organized in which 2110 students and 163 staff members were benefitted.
- A comparative report for the previous quarters (April 2018 to March 2019) pertaining to the campus placements organized by Centre for Institution Industry Interaction (CIII) was presented. Totally 49 companies visited the campus for placement selection and 472 students have been placed.
