

SALIENT FEATURES OF PERIYAR MANIAMMAI UNIVERSITY

- The total land area of our University is 219.08 acres, and the total built up area (including Hostel) is 92,084.90 sq.m with the value of about Rs.154 crores.
- The strength of students on roll as on 11/04/2016 is 3508. At present, the strength of faculty is 254 and the administrative and supporting staff are 255.
- We follow the rules and regulations and also the nomenclature suggested by University Grants Commission (UGC), All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), COA (Council of Architecture), NCTE (National Council for Teachers Education), etc. for all the academic programmes, scrupulously.
- National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) Peer team visited our institution for cycle-2 accreditation from 02/11/15 to 05/11/15 and accredited with 'B' grade score of 2.66 in the four point scale.
- As directed by UGC, our Institution got registered with NIRF(National Institutional Ranking Framework) of Minstry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), an online ranking of educational Institutions in India. The data required by the NIRF were uploaded on 13/01/2016 as per discipline wise i.e., Architecture, Management, Engineering and University level (Arts & Science).
- Our Institution had submitted online application for renewal of recognition with SIRO (Scientific Industrial Research Organization) on 13/01/2016 for Special exemption from tax on purchasing laboratory equipments.
- The University is one of the Senior Member Institutions under National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (NMEICT), MHRD, Government of India.
- From the academic year 2015-16 onwards, Outcome Based Education (OBE) is being practiced for UG and PG programmes.
- For the academic year 2015-2016, NCTE accorded approval for 2 year B.Ed programme and 4 year B.Sc B.Ed. programme. Twenty three students have enrolled under B.Sc B.Ed. programme.
- An integrated 5 Year M.Tech (Nano Technology) Programme started under School of Engineering and Technology and Seventeen students have enrolled.
- Re-certification of International Standard Organization ISO 9001:2008 was conducted by the auditing team from Det Norske Veritas Germanischer Lloyd (DNV-GL), Chennai. The Auditing team had re-certified the University Quality Manangement System (UQMS) till 6th September 2018.
- UQMS had organised ISO 9001 2008 Auditor Training for 18 senior faculty members on 17th & 18th March 2016. A written examination was conducted on the second day and evaluated by the ISO trainer. These 18 qualified auditors will assist

the University in conducting the internal auditing on regular basis.

- All the departments are equipped with ICT enabled class rooms, also with Wi-fi connectivity, LCD projectors and Interactive Smart Board.
- Our university practices e-based teaching learning process. National Programme on Technology Enable Learning (NPTEL) repositories and virtual labs from Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Centre for Distance Engineering Education Programme (CDEEP) and online webinars from IIT Mumbai are available for use. NMEICT programmes with open courseware materials and video lectures are available on the Periyar Net, an Intranet of the University. Online database can be accessed through Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET). Sharing of resources is facilitated through Developing Library Network (DELNET).
- Provision for integrating online courses with curriculum for Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral Programmes are also introduced.
- PMU has developed e-contents for all the subjects which are made available in Periyar Net for effective use of teaching learning process.
- Indigenous software developed in PMU called Brilliant Recourses for Academic Institutions (BRAIN) has released the latest version by name, BRAIN V2.15 on October 2015.
- PMU APP developed for iphone Operating System (iOS) & Android as a part of BRAIN and it dynamically supports current calendar of events, news, student attendance status, fees status and exam results.
- There are three women hostels with 380 rooms accommodating 576 students and a gent's hostel with 570 student rooms and 6 guest rooms. From May 2015 to March 2016, we received 328 tones of solid waste from Thanjavur Municipal Corporation and with this solid waste, Bio gas was generated at our biomethanization plant with the energy consumption equivalence of 30 LPG cylinders which is used in our hostels.

- The University has already committed to various green practices towards zero carbon by massive tree planting, resorting to Alternative Building Material (ABM), energy efficient Gadgets , Rain water harvesting , Solid and Liquid waste management, paper reprocessing , renewable energy , biomethanization plant, rearing 10 varieties of bamboo cultivation under National Bamboo Mission Programme.
