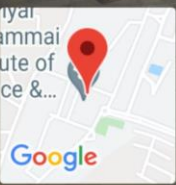
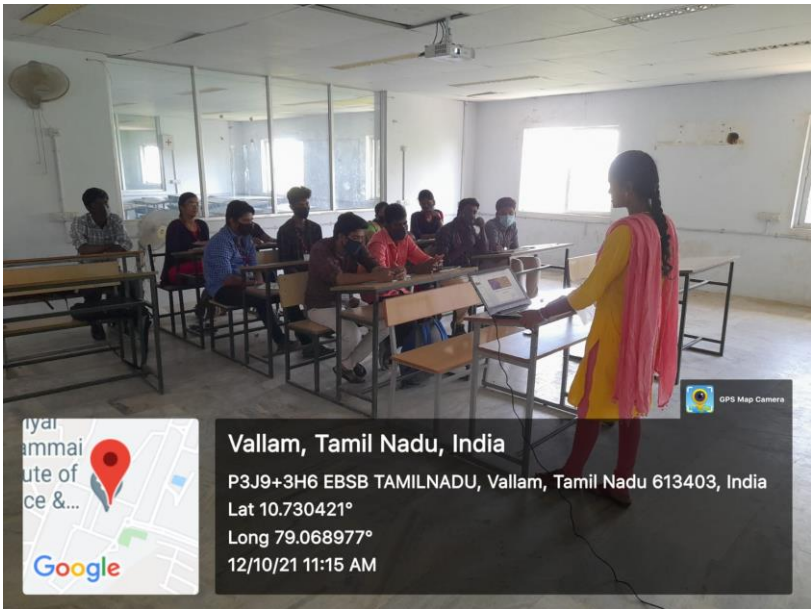
Webinar on Nobel Prizes in Chemistry in recent decades
