Name of the programme :

Objective of the programme : To create knowledge about the Indian constitution and importance of Republic and Democracy among students , and to make awareness about the kinds of rights available for a citizen in the Indian constitution and how it valid in the current Society.

Briefing the scope of the event : Constitution day also known as national law day is celebrated in the India on 26th November every year to commemorate the adoption of the constitution of India on November 26th ,1949. Hence in order to observe the completion of 75st constitution day and Republic day 2025 the Department of Political Science organized a National Level Symposium . On 28th January 2025, the symposium have been conducted in the title **The Living Document - Relevance of the Constitution Today**. Dr.D. AarthiSaravanan , Head of the Department delivered the welcome address of the programme , Dr. P. Vijayalakshmi, Dean/FSH, delivered the Special address. And Miss. T.K. Amritha, Additional Secretary of our Student Association (Visionary Voices) Introduced the Guest. On the part of the programme both Technical and non technical sessions were conducted, overall there are 97 participants from various departments and colleges . there are 35 paper presentation in the technical session and 48 students were participated in the non technical sessions such as Dance, Mime, Drawing & Poster presentations, Drama, Ethnic walk.

The chief speakers :

Dr. SivakumarSomasundaram, Associate Professor, PG Program Coordinator, The School of Governance and Development Management of Hawassa University, Ethiopia.

Dr. SivakumarSomasundharamgave information about fundamental rights and what are all the constitutional remedies available for a citizen in India. He explains clearly about the writs such as Habeas Corpus, Mandamus, Prohibition, Certiorari, Quo-Warranto and how these writs can protect the constitutional rights of a citizen. Further he explained fundamental rights article 14 to 36 in the Indian constitution, he highlighted about right to life and expression

and property rights in India. He gave guideline to the participants that how can these rights can used by the people and what are all the procedure available to approach the courts when this rights are violated. And further explain about fundamental rights and in that he expressed his experiences in his pleadings related to language rights. He gave his ideas about the need and importance to protect our language right and the importance of learning and protecting our language. Further he said that the freedom to express ourselves is the fundamental human rights, and it is basic right of a person to communicate his ideas and thoughts in his language to his friends and other community members. He also explains using of regional languages in the court arguments and using if Tamil Language in temple poojas. He gave many case example related to the language issues and language rights.

After the speakers sessions there was the question hour, some of the students and staffs ask question related to the topic of the webinar and the guests clarify the questions and the session was end with the vote of thanks which was give by Miss.K.Vaishnavi , Student of B.A.Political science-1st year delivered the vote of thanks. The programme was concluded with a valedictory and prize distribution.
