- Educational psychology and adaptive learning techniques

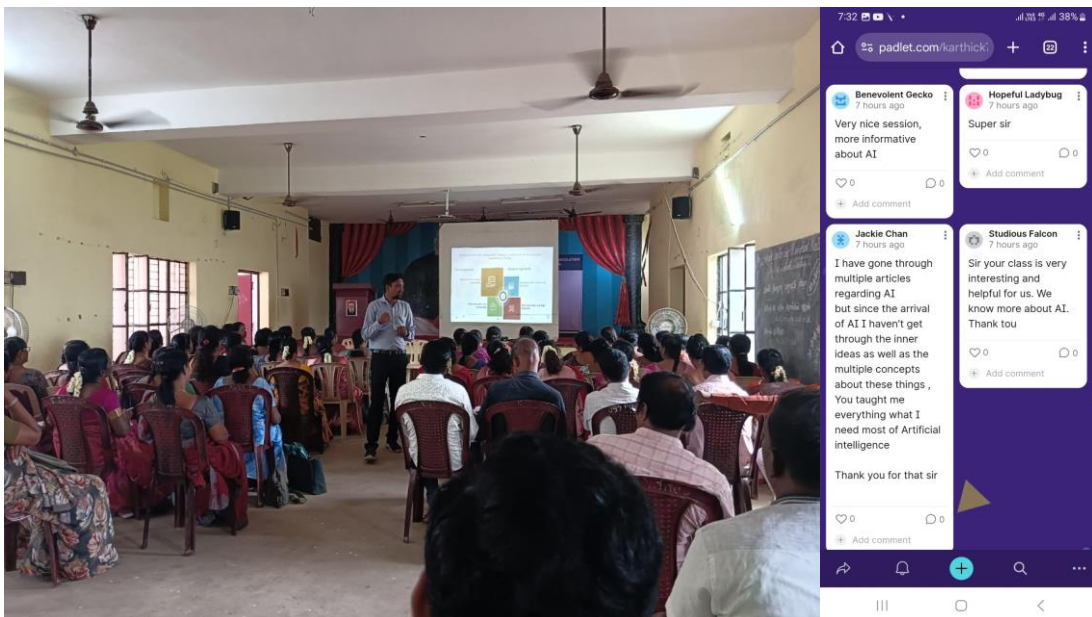
- Communication and empathy in modern teaching
- Leadership mindset and organizational growth

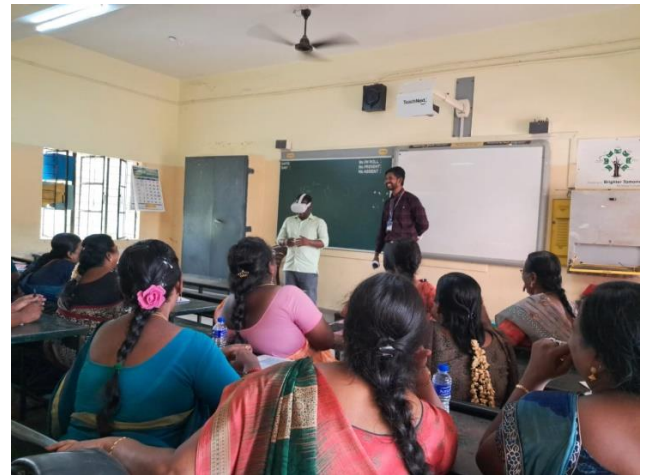
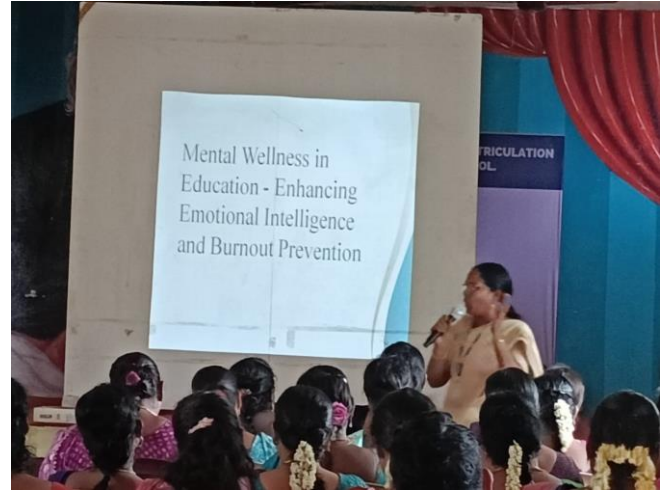
