BUSINESS CLASS HOTEL DESIGN

The third-year students of the Department of Architecture embarked on a case study visit on 21.03.2024 to Vignesh Residency in Srirangam, Trichy as part of their XAR606 - Architectural Design - V course. 


INDUSTRIAL EXPOSURE





The office design features a running landscape encircling the work area, with a central circular ramp serving as the focal point. Form development utilizes radial layout, with workstations at the center and team leader cabins arranged in radial fashion, facilitating guidance. Additionally, the radial form serves as buffer space for workstations and provides access between floors while offering relaxation and greenery for a pleasant atmosphere.


