Around 1964 Post Graduates, Research Scholars, Research Scientists, Faculty members and other interested participants have participated from various higher educational institutions from South America (Texila American University - Zambia) and all over India such as Central University of Gujarat, Central University of South Bihar, Central University of Tamilnadu, Central University of Haryana, Central University of Karnataka, IIT Roorkee, IIT BOMBAY, IIT Mandi, Indian Institute of Science Education and Research (IISER) Kolkata, CSIR-IICT, Hyderabad, Advance Institute of Biotech and Paramedical Sciences, Kanpur, School of Life Sciences, Agra and State Universities such as Madurai Kamaraj University, Alagappa University, Bharathidasan University, Gandhigram Rural University, Periyar University, Thiruvalluvar University, Mother Teresa Women’s University, Anna University, University of Madras, Goa University, University of Rajasthan, University of Kashmir, Utkal University, Dibrugarh University, Lucknow University, Kashmir University, Jaipur National University and private universities such as Vellore Institute of Technology, and Avinashilingam University. Among 1964 participants, 1029 participants secured the eligible score in the online quiz and e-certificates were issued to them.
