Periyar Maniammai Institute of Science & Technology (PMIST) has its organizational root from Periyar Maniammai College of Technology for Women (PMCTW), the very first engineering college in the world exclusively for the women. Established during 1988, bearing the names of two great social reformers; E V Ramasamy widely respected as "Thanthai Periyar" and his philanthropic wife Annai Maniammaiyyar. PMIST has revolutionized women's education especially the higher studies in Engineering, Technology and Science. Approved by AICTE and functioned under various Universities like Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli and Anna University during the transition period.

Periyar Maniammai Institute of Science & Technology has grown over the years, in leaps and bounds encompassing almost every sphere of technology which were once the domains exclusively for the males. With effect from August 17, 2007, it attained the status of Deemed to be University, under section 3 of UGC act 1956. It paved way for initiating co-education attracting both boys and girls.

The Periyar Maniammai Institute of Science & Technology is situated in a land area encompassing 114.65 acres. ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY AND PROCEDURE 2025-26
SELECTION PROCEDURE
UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMMES

B.Arch.

Admission to B.Arch. programme is based on the merit list prepared with eligible marks in aptitude test (NATA -National Aptitude Test in Architecture) / JEE -Mains-paper-II and the Qualifying examination (10+2 scheme of examination with at least 50 % aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and also at least 50 % marks in aggregate of the 10+2 level examination or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 50% marks aggregate)

B.Tech. (Regular)/ B.Tech. (Hons.)

- Preference will be given to candidates qualifying in PMIST Entrance Examination (PMISE conducted by PMIST) or JEE-Mains or Uniguage or any other State/National level Entrance Examination conducted by competent authority.
- Admission to B.Tech. programme is based on the merit list prepared with the normalized cut off marks obtained in the qualifying examination.

B.Tech. (Lateral Entry)/ B.Tech. (Hons.)

Lateral Entry will be given to candidates qualifying in Diploma Examination (recognized by DOTE) to Second year of the Degree Courses in Engineering and Technology, permissible to a maximum of 10% of the 'Approved Intake' which shall be over and above the supernumerary to the 'Approved Intake', plus the unfilled vacancies of the first year.

OTHER UG PROGRAMMES

For all the other UG programmes (Arts, Sciences, Management and Humanities-B.Sc./BCA/B.Com/BBA/BA/B.Sc., B.Ed/B.Ed) seats are filled with the merit list prepared based on marks obtained in the qualifying examination like PMESE/CUET/Any other State/National level Entrance Examinations.

POST GRADUATE PROGRAMMES

For all PG programmes (Arts, Sciences, Management and Humanities-MBA/M.Com/MCA/M.Sc./MA/MSW), seats are filled with the merit list prepared based on marks obtained in the qualifying examination like PMESE/TANCET/CAT/Any other State level/National Level Entrance Examinations.

For all PG Engineering M.Tech/M.Arch programmes, Preference will be given to candidates like PMESE/GATE/TANCET/any other State /National level entrance examinations conducted by the competent authority.

Ph. D PROGRAMMES

- For all Ph.D programmes, seats are filled with the merit list prepared based on marks in the qualifying examination like PMIST Entrance examination and personal interview.
- The number of available seats in all the specializations under different disciplines will be determined well in advance and the same will be notified in the Periyar Maniammal Institute of Science & Technology (PMIST) website.
- The candidates desirous of pursuing Ph.D. degree should submit the application in the prescribed format through proper channel wherever applicable, before the last date to the Director (Admissions). The application format and the necessary details are available in the PMIST website.
- The received applications will be sent to the respective Faculty Deans / HODs for selecting eligible candidates. The list of eligible candidates will be sent to Director (Admissions) as well as to Dean (Research) and the candidates will be called to appear for an entrance test.
- The candidates need to appear for a personal interview before the Department Research Committee comprising of HOD and all eligible supervisors.
- The selection of the candidates is subject to the final approval of PMIST Selection Committee.
- Dean (Research) will seek the approval of the Vice-Chancellor for the provisional registration of the selected candidates.
- Dean (Research) will send the selection orders to the eligible candidates through Registered post by marking copies to the Department Research Coordinator (DRC).

- The selected candidates should submit all his/her original certificates along with the course fees on or before the last date.
- Department Research Coordinator (DRC) and HOD will allocate the Supervisor.

RESERVATION:

Reservation policy will be followed as per the norms of Ministry of Human Resources Development (MHRD), Govt. of India.

OTHER STATE CANDIDATES:

Other state students should furnish the Nativity Certificate and Migration certificate issued by the competent authority.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMMES

B.Arch.

- Candidate should have passed 10+2 Examination with at least 50 % aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and also at least 50 % marks in aggregate of the 10+2 level examination.

OR

- Candidate should have passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 50 % marks in aggregate.

AND

- Qualifying NATA (National Aptitude Test in Architecture) examination / JEE-Mains-Paper-II.

B.Tech. (Regular)

- Candidate should have passed 10+2 examination with any three of the following Physics / Mathematics / Chemistry / Computer Science / Electronics / Information Technology / Biology / Informatics Practices / Biotechnology / Technical Vocational Subject / Agriculture / Engineering Graphics / Business Studies / Entrepreneurship.

- Candidate should have obtained at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in the above subjects taken together.

OR

- Candidates qualifying in Diploma Examination (recognized by DOTE) with at least 45 % marks (40 % marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) subject to the vacancies in the First year, in case the vacancies at lateral entry are exhausted.

- PMIST will offer suitable bridge courses such as Mathematics, Physics, Engineering drawing, etc., for the students coming from diverse backgrounds to achieve desired learning outcomes of the Programme.

- Candidate should have passed Minimum Three years / Two Years (Lateral Entry) Diploma Examination with at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in any branch of Engineering and Technology.

- Candidate should have passed B.Sc. Degree from a recognized University as defined by UGC, with at least 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) and passed 10+2 examination with Mathematics as a subject.

OR

- Candidate should have passed D.Voc. Stream in the same or allied sector.
- PMIST will offer suitable bridge courses such as Mathematics, Physics, Engineering drawing, etc., for the students coming from diverse backgrounds to achieve desired learning outcomes of the Programme.

B.Tech. (Hons.) Degree Programme

Honours is a specialized degree that focuses on the area of the students' interest, which encourages advanced levels of study and multidisciplinary learning. Honours qualification enhances professional development and facilitates gaining recognition at the time of graduation for advanced and distinguished work contributed by the under graduate students.

Eligibility Criteria for Registration

Every student at the Institute intending to register for the 'Honours' qualification shall fulfill the following academic requirements:

- a. Registration to 'Honours' qualification shall start from third semester onwards.
- b. Students should have passed all the courses of first and second semesters in the first attempt and have an overall 8.0 CGPA.
- c. The lateral entry students / B.Sc. graduates should undergo two additional courses as recommended by the respective department, one course in the 3rd semester and the other course in the 4th semester.

Registration Procedure

- i. Any student who meets the eligibility criteria specified above and intends to register for the 'Honours' qualification shall apply to the Institute through HoD in a prescribed form along with the prescribed application fee within 15 days after notification by the Institute.
- ii. There will be no limit on the intake of students for registration for 'Honours' qualification.
- iii. Notification for approved registrants will be notified by the Dean (Academic Courses) within a week after application.
- iv. If registered, the students shall pay a one-time non-refundable registration fee as prescribed by the Institute to confirm the registration.

B.C.A

- Candidate should have passed 10+2 Examination or equivalent with Mathematics / Business Mathematics / Computer Science / Computer Applications / Statistics as one of the subjects.
OR
- Passed Technical Diploma Examination with Mathematics / Business Mathematics / Statistics / Computer Science as one of the subjects.

B.Sc. - Data Science

- Candidate should have passed 10+2 Examination or equivalent with Mathematics / Business Mathematics / Computer Science / Computer Applications / Statistics as one of the subjects.

REFUND POLICIES

EXAMINATION SYSTEM

Internal Assessment Tools & End Semester Examination

Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) and model examinations will be conducted in the departments and HoD or senior member appointed by the HoD will be Chief Superintendent. The stationeries will be provided by the CoE office.

Model Question papers have to be submitted to the CoE for end semester exams. The department will preserve the answer scripts until the audit is done. Questions are directly related to COs and hence random generation of questions cannot be done.

For CIA, model Exams and End Semester Examinations Question paper patterns given by COE shall follow. However, for selected subjects, the QP pattern will be different as approved by the Dean of the faculty concerned. Students who are representing the PMIST with prior permission from HoD, Faculty Dean, and Dean(Academic courses) will be given retest for CIA and model exams. No retest will be conducted for whatsoever other reasons may be. No Hall ticket is needed for writing CIA and model exams.

Assessment for Seminar / Professional Practices

The Seminar / Professional Practices / Case study / Mini-Project shall carry 100 marks and shall be evaluated through continuous assessment only.

Assessment for Industrial / Practical Training / Internship / Summer Project

The Industrial / Practical Training shall carry 100 marks and shall be evaluated through continuous assessment only.

Assessment of semester long industrial project / internship

The Viva-voce examination for semester long industrial project or internship shall be based on the report submitted by the student regarding the work carried out in the industrial project or internship.

Assessment for Value Added Courses

The one / two credit course shall carry 100 marks and shall be evaluated through continuous assessments only.

Assessment for Online Courses

Students may be permitted to credit online courses (NPTEL / SWAYAM) with the approval of the Head of the Department and Dean (Academic Courses), subject to a maximum of six credits.

Open Elective

As per the UGC / AKTE norms, the students will be permitted to select the open elective subjects from third to seventh semester. Students are encouraged to take online courses as per UGC norms.

Attendance requirement for End Semester Examinations:

1. A student shall normally be permitted to appear for the End Semester Examinations, if he / she has gained 75% attendance in a course.
2. If a student has attendance between 65% and 75% in any course during the current semester and provides valid reasons (participation in college / university / national / international level competitions / NSS / NCC / NSO / YRC / RRC / internships with prior approval) supported by all necessary documents, he or she may be permitted to appear for the current End Semester Examinations.
3. If a student has attendance between 65% and 75% in any course during the current semester and provides valid reasons (hospitalization / accidents / specific illness / unforeseen incidents) supported by all necessary documents, he or she may be permitted to appear for the current End Semester Examinations by paying IQs. 1,000/- per course as coordination fee.

Minimum Marks Required for Pass in Each Segment & Overall Passing Minimum

There is no passing minimum for CIA. However, a student must secure:

1. Minimum 40% in ESE (includes Theory cum Lab) and 50% in total (overall) for all UG Programmes in Engineering, Architecture, and all PG Programmes
2. Minimum 35% in ESE (includes Theory cum Lab) and 40% in total (overall) for all UG Arts, Science and Humanities and Education programmes.

Supplementary Examination

If a student fails to secure a pass in a course, the student shall register and appear for the end semester examination in the subsequent semester or appear for the supplementary examination. However, from the third attempt onwards, if a student fails to obtain pass marks i.e., (Continuous Assessment + End Semester Examination), then the student shall be declared to have passed the examination if he / she secures a minimum of 50 percent of marks prescribed for the end semester examinations alone.

LIBRARY

The Institute Library holds at present 106166 Books, 155 National Journals and Magazines, 208 International and Online Journals, 8 dailies, 2,368 Audio and Video CDs. The book bank of this library has 3,626 books. Library has been automated and it is possible to locate any book instantly. The Library is kept open from 8.15 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. on all working days.

The Institute Library is having the institutional membership of the British Council Library, DELNET, INFLIBNET - Shodhganga and Tamil University. The library subscribes J-Gate Science and Technology Database, ProQuest Database, IEEE Online Journals. This library provides opportunity for staff and students to borrow necessary titles from these sources and also to browse journals. A Digital Library is available in the Library. Other features in the Library are,

- A Separate Section with Competitive Exam books is maintained.
- Books are arranged according to DDC (Dewey Decimal Classification) System for easy search.
- The library information Management system is maintained through the BRAIN Software of this University.
- The availability of the books could be searched easily through OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) system.
- The subscribed e- resources can be accessed through Remote Access.
- Photo copying facility is available in the Library.

PROCEDURE

In the Library following procedure is adopted for the issuing of books.

1. Student or Staff member is entitled for the borrowing facilities as,

2. The Borrowers ID card enables to take the books.
3. The Borrowers will be held responsible for any loss, damage, or non-return of the books issued against her/his ID Card.
4. The students may keep the borrowed books for 15 days from the date of issue. Otherwise a fine of Rs.5.00 per day will be collected, for not returning the book on or before the due date.
5. The staff members may keep books for six months (or) renewed. Otherwise a fine of Rs.5.00 per day will be collected, for not returning the book on or before the due date.
6. The borrowers who fail to pay the fine for belated return of books will not be allowed to borrow from the library until the fine is paid.
7. The outgoing students shall return all the books at the end of the respective academic year and get necessary clearance certificate from the Librarian.

LOSS OF BOOKS

1. The loss of Library books should be reported immediately
2. If any book is lost, the borrower should replace it by a new book or she/ he will be required to pay triple the cost of the published price of the book and with a fine of Rs.100/-.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED IN THE LIBRARY

1. The users of the library are strictly instructed to leave all their books, notebooks and bags outside the Library.
2. Cell phones are not allowed.
3. Strict silence should be observed in the Library.
4. The Books, Periodicals and Journals taken for reading should be kept in the reading table, need not to be replaced.
5. Current periodicals and Journals will not be issued.
6. Reference books are meant for reference in the Library itself by the students and Staff. Reference books will not be issued.



WHAT CONSTITUTES RAGGING

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts

- a. Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;
- b. Indulging in rowdiness or in disciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student;
- c. Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student;
- d. Any act by a any student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
- e. Exploiting the service of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students;
- f. Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student.
- g. Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- h. Any act or abuse by spoken words, e-mails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious thrill from actively or passively participating in the discrimination to fresher or any other student;
- i. Any act that affects the mental health and self confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority over any fresher or any other student.

BUS - RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Students should follow the dress code
2. Boys have to wear full pants and shirts tucked in and formal shoes. They are not allowed to wear safari, pyjamas, dhoti, stonewash pants and jeans.
3. Girls have to wear churidar with properly pinned thupattas or Pant and Shirt. They are not allowed to wear miniskirt, midi, short churidar, sleeveless garments and tight pants

9. Students are prohibited from indulging in anti-institutional, anti-national, anti-social, communal, immoral or political expressions and activities in the bus.
10. Students shall not deface, disfigure, damage or destroy or cause any loss in any manner to or regarding public, private or Periyar Mariammal Institute of Science & Technology properties.
11. Unauthorized entry of outsiders into the bus is strictly prohibited.

12. No one shall exhibit any type of banners, flags, boards etc., inside or outside the bus.
13. Any conduct, which leads to lowering of the reputation of Periyar Mariammal Institute of Science & Technology, is prohibited.
14. Students found travelling without paying fees will be punished
15. Students are not permitted to enter or stay inside the bus during class hours.
16. Students shall not interfere with driver and other Staff. They shall not seek any favours from the driver. They should inform staff i/c of the bus in case of any difference of opinion or any inconvenience to the students.
17. Students are strictly not permitted to get down in between Stops other than the Institution Stop and the Boarding points.

All candidates admitted to various programmes of the Institute are expected to adhere to the following terms and conditions to ensure academic excellence, discipline, and a safe learning environment.

CC1.1 ஒழுங்கு நடவடிக்கை: மாணவர்களின், பொறுப்பின்மை மற்றும் ஒழுக்கம் தவறிய மாணவர்களைக் கண்டறிவும் நிலையில் அவர்கள் இவற்றை விட மாணவர்களின் குறைபாடுகள் மற்றும் குறைபாடுகள் தொடர்பான விவரங்களைப் பற்றும் மாணவர்களின் கல்வி, ஒழுக்கம், கட்டுப்பாடு, பாதுகாப்புள்ள கல்வி கற்கும் சூழலை உறுதி செய்தல் ஆகியவற்றின் பொருட்டு, மாணவர்கள் பின்வரும் விதிகளைக் கடைபிடிக்க வேண்டுகிறோம். உறுதியாக பின்பற்றுவதில் தாமதம் செய்யக்கூடாது.

Disciplinary Action: Any student found engaging in disobedient or indisciplined behaviour will be subject to strict disciplinary action, including immediate expulsion from the Institute.

CC1.2 ஆணை கட்டுப்பாடு: கல்வி நிறுவன வளத்தில் மாணவர்கள் ஊழல்படிகளும் அடக்கமற்றும் இடக்க வேண்டியது இன்றியமையாததாகும். தானியான ஆணை அளிக்கும் வேண்டும். மேலும் தொடர்புடைய ஊழலின் காரணமாக அடக்கப்படும் காரணம் ஒன்று நடவடிக்கை தவறாமல் கீழ்க்கண்ட விதிகளைக் கடைபிடிக்க வேண்டும்.

Dress Code: Students must wear neat, modest, and appropriate attire while on campus. Uniform dress is mandatory three days a week, as per the schedule notified by the respective departments.

- CC1.3** **வன்றாற தவிர்ந்தல்:** மாணவர்கள், ஆசிரியர்கள், ஆசிரியர்கள் பணியாளர்களிடம் சண்டையிடுதல், வன்றாறம் செய்தல் உடல் மொழியால் கேலிக்கூறு செய்தல், மொழி மொழிகளை கண்டித்தல் ஆகிய செயல்களில் ஈடுபடக்கூடாது. தங்களுக்கு ஏற்படும் நன்றாறங்களை உரிய வழியாக சம்பந்தப்பட்ட அலுவலருக்கு உடனிடம் தெரிவிக்க வேண்டும்.

Non-Violence Policy: Students must refrain from quarrelling or engaging in any form of physical or verbal conflict with fellow students, faculty, or staff. Any grievance must be reported to the mentor or the concerned authority through appropriate channels.

- CC1.4** **மாணவர் கல்வி இடைநீக்கம்:** தேவையற்ற வன்றாறம், சண்டை, மற்றும் கண்டையி ஆகியவற்றில் ஈடுபடும் மாணவர்கள் உடனடியாக கல்வி வன்றாறம் இடைநீக்கம் செய்து நிறுவனத்திலிருந்து இடைநீக்கம் செய்யும் நிரந்தர நீக்கம் செய்யப்படுவர். ஒரேவேளை இடைநீக்கம் செய்யப்பட்ட மாணவர்கள் ஊரும் கல்விவயத தொடர வாய்ப்பளிக்கும்படிபடல் அடிப்படையிலும் மாணவியு அடித்தலுடன் ரூபாய் 10,000 (பத்தாயிரம்) தண்டம் (பேரூபாய்) செலுத்த வேண்டும்.

Suspension and Penalty for Violence: Students found involved in any quarrel or fight will be immediately suspended indefinitely. If the act is severe, the student may be removed from the Institute's rolls. Reinstatement of suspended students, if considered, will require a written apology and payment of a penalty of Rs.10,000/-.

Attendance Requirement: Students must satisfy the minimum attendance requirement as per Institute regulations. Students failing to meet this requirement will not be permitted to progress to the next semester.

Re-registration for Courses: Students who are detained due to shortage of attendance must redo all courses of the concerned semester by paying the prescribed tuition and examination fees.

Discontinuation and Scholarship Refund: Students who discontinue their studies in the middle of a course period are required to repay the full amount of any scholarship received. Transfer Certificate and other documents will be issued only upon settlement of dues, including scholarship recovery, if applicable.

Other Violations: Vandalism or damage to Institute property will be strictly dealt with, and the student will be liable for the cost of damages.
