ORDER

WHEREAS, the institution **Periyar Maniammal University, Department of Education, School of Humanities Universities, Science & Management, Periyar Nagar, Vallam, Thanjavur-613403, Tamilnadu** was granted recognition vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed./2009/15854 dated 25.09.2009 (P-327/Coors.) for conducting B.Ed. course of one year' duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2009-2010.

2. AND WHEREAS, the Tamilnadu Teachers Education University had forwarded a copy of show cause notice issued to the institution for not functioning in accordance with the conditions stipulated by the NCTE, SRC, Bangalore and Tamilnadu Teachers Education University as could be apprehended from the report of Inspection commission which caused a surprise visit to the colleges.

3. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit dt. 30.04.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations.

4. AND WHEREAS, provisional revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 13.05.2015 for conducting **B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.**

5. AND WHEREAS, the University has submitted its written representation in respect of the condition mentioned in RPRO dt. 29.10.2015. The matter was considered the SRC in its 380th meeting held on 18th – 19th September, 2019 and decided to issue **Final Show Cause Notice**. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 25.09.2019 was issued.

6. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st October – 01st November, 2019 considered and decided as the following grounds:

- (i) The Building plan submitted by the Institution is signed by Registered Architect whereas the same should be approved by the competent Govt. Authority.

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- (ii) The built up area shown is not adequate for both B.Ed. and B.Sc.B.Ed. programme.
- (iii) The approved staff list both for B.Ed. & B.Sc.B.Ed are repetitive and the number of faculty required are not as per NCTE norms.

In view of the above, the Committee decided that to withdraw the recognition granted to Periyar Maniammal University, Department of Education School of Humanities Universities, Science & Management, Periyar Nagar, Vallam, Thanjavur-613403, Tamilnadu for conducting B.Ed. & B.Sc.B.Ed. course under clause 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.

7. AND WHEREAS, a withdrawal order was issued to the institution vide dt.06.11.2019. Thereafter, the institution preferred an appeal u/s 17 of NCTE Act, 1993 and the Appellate Authority vide order No. F.No.89-18/E-149686/2020 Appeal/8th Mtg.-2020/27th February, 2020 dt.15.07.2020 **remanded back the matter to SRC**. The operative part of the order is as under :-

"AND WHEREAS after perusal of the Memoranda of Appeal, affidavit, documents on record and oral arguments advanced during the hearing. Appeal Committee concluded to remand back the case to the SRC with a direction to consider the documents submitted in appeal and take further action as per the NCTE Regulations, 2014. The appellant is directed to forward to the SRC all the documents submitted in appeal within 15 days of receipt of order on the appeal.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council hereby remands back the case of Periyar Maniammal Institute of Science & Technology (PMIST) (Deemed to be University), Periyar Nagar, Vallam Thanjavur, Tamilnadu to the SRC, NCTE, for necessary action as indicated above."

8. AND WHEREAS, the institution vide letter dt.05.08.2020 had submitted the documents.

9. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 387th meeting held on 24th – 25th August, 2020 considered and decided as the following grounds:

"The Committee decided to write a letter to the Institution asking therein to submit the following documents: -

1. The institution is required to submit a copy of notification issued for the appointment of the faculty and appointment orders issued to the faculty members.

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In view of the above, the Committee decided to seek the above documents from the Institution by sending a last reminder (Letter) before withdrawal of the recognition on the grounds mentioned above to the institution. The institution is required to submit the documents / representation mentioned above within 21 days from the date of issue of the letter."

10. AND WHEREAS, a letter was issued to the institution vide dated 01.09.2020. The institution has submitted its reply along with documents vide dated 07.09.2020 The University has submitted copy of Appointment Letters in respect of 25 faculty members (B.Ed. Course) and 19 faculty members (B.Sc.B.Ed. Course).

11. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 388th meeting held on 14th 15th September, 2020 considered and decided as the following grounds:

"The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution vide letter dt 07.09.2020, the Committee decided that the **continuation order** be issued to the Institution **Periyar Maniammal University, Vallam, Thanjavur-613403, Tamilnadu** for *following existing courses:-*

- (i) *B.Ed - 2 units (50 students each unit).*
- (ii) *B.Sc.B.Ed - 1 unit of 50 students."*

12. NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **Periyar Maniammal University, Department of Education, School of Humanities Universities, Science & Management, Periyar Nagar, Vallam, Thanjavur-613403, Tamilnadu** for continuation of recognition for B.Ed. course of two year duration with an intake of 2 basic units of 50 students each unit subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.

- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
13. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc as applicable.
14. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
15. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-
- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
 - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e. Fee charged from students;
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities;
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
16. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.


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17. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
18. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provision of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
