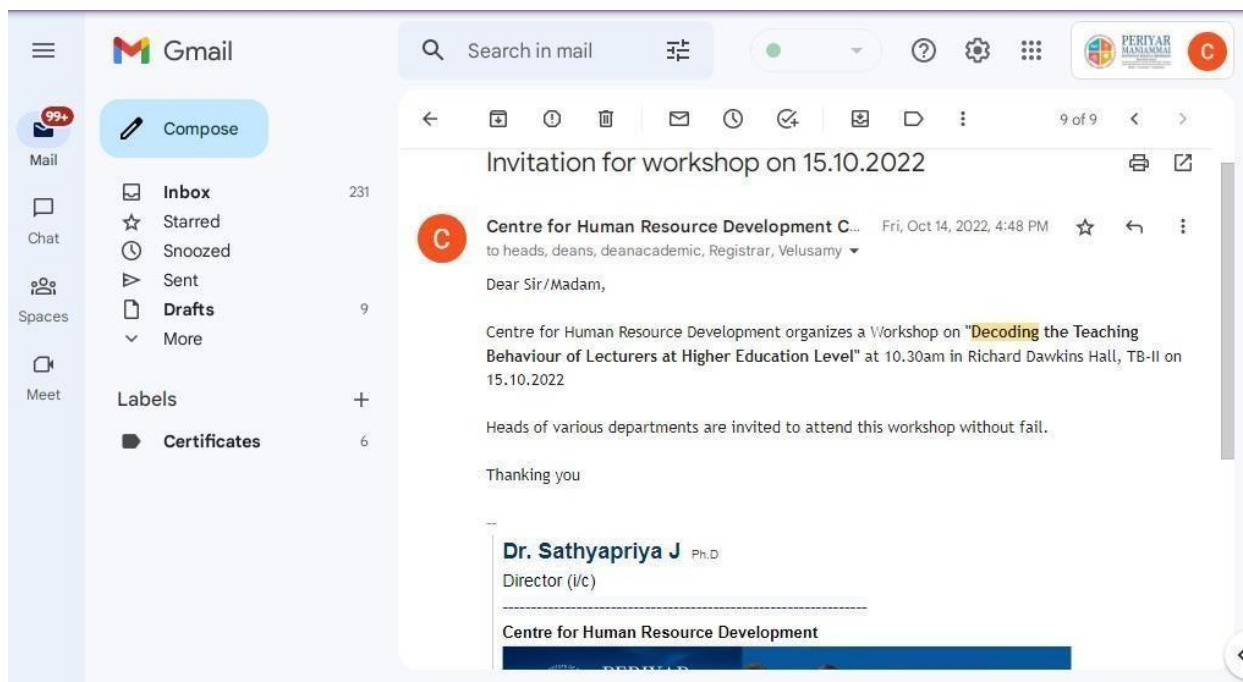

## **Programme report**

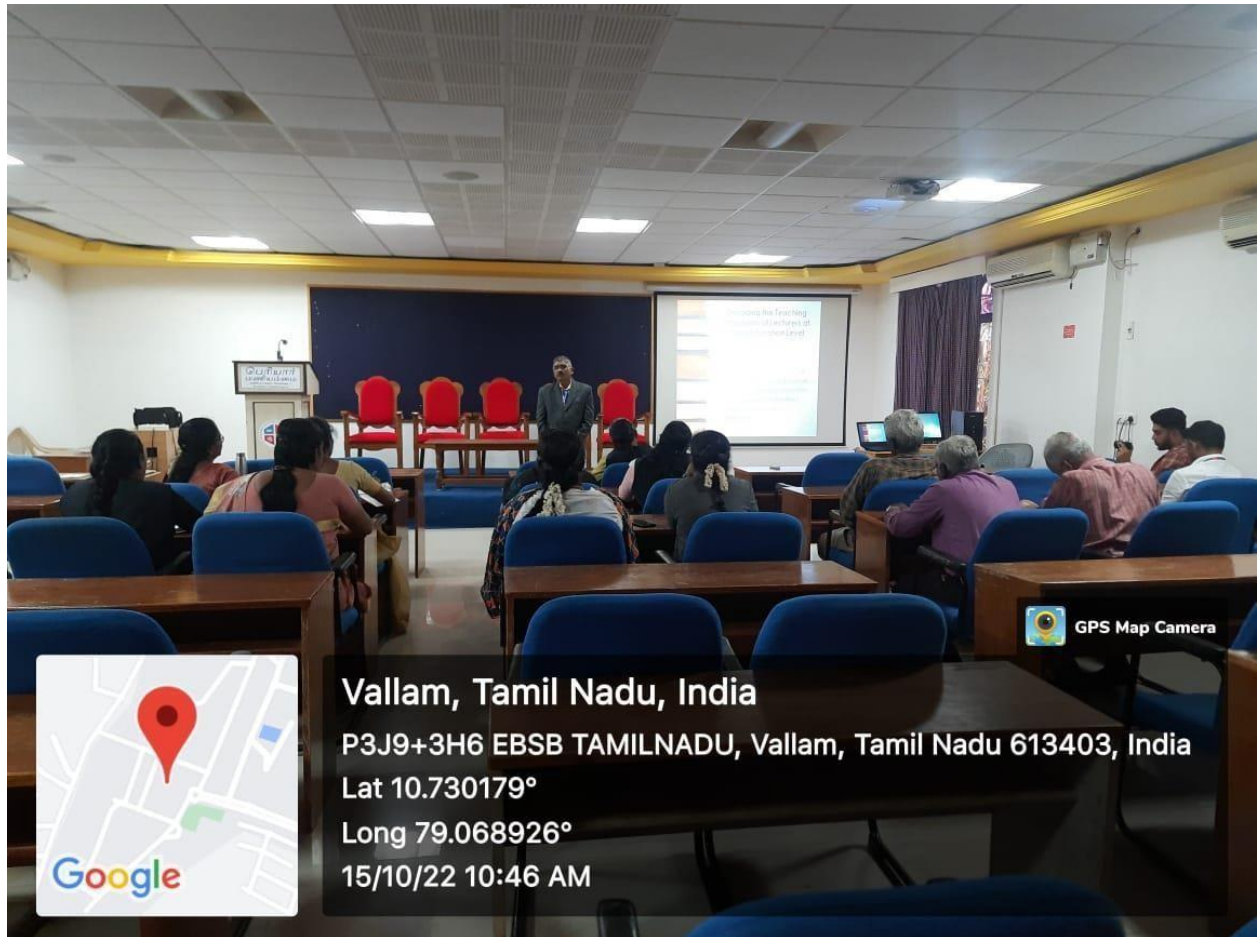

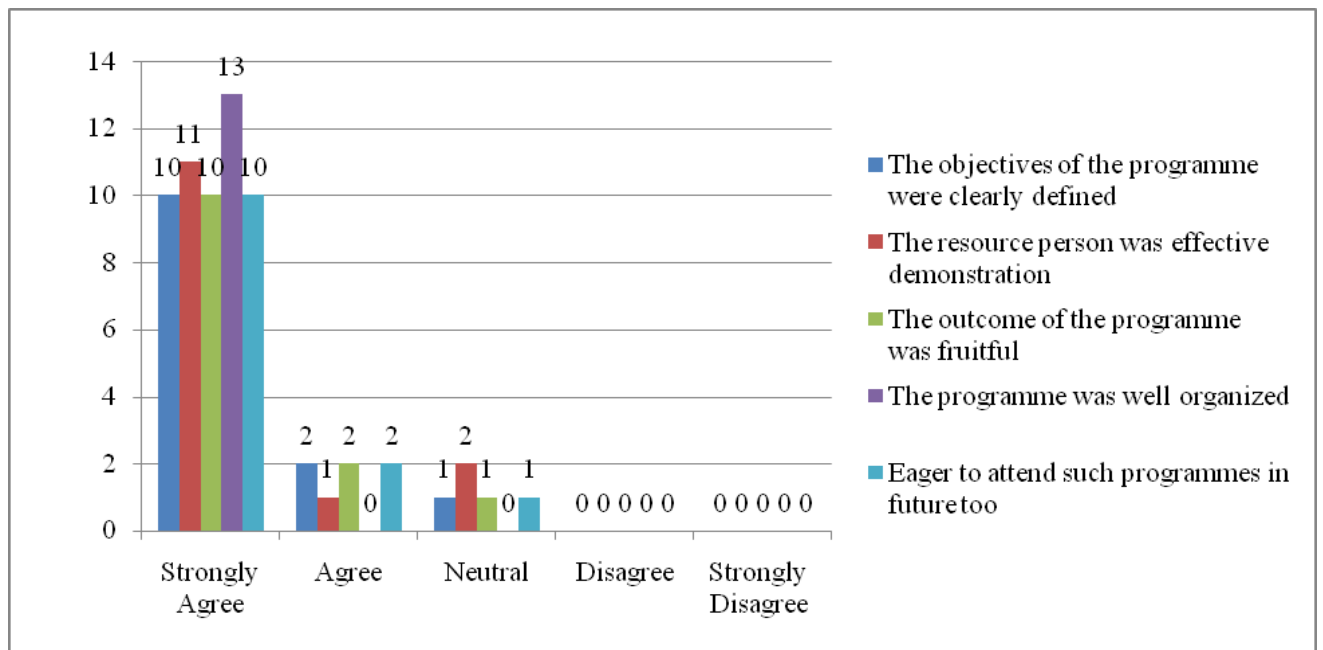
