## Programme Report

The Faculty Induction Programme “Guru Dakshata (2022-23) Batch – II” was organized by Centre for Human Resource Development from 19<sup>th</sup> June to 21<sup>st</sup> July 2023. The inauguration of the FIP was held on 19<sup>th</sup> June 2023. Dr.Sathyapriya j, Director (i/c), Centre for Human Resource Development welcomed the gathering and highlighted the objectives of Guru Dakshata.

Prof. S.Velusami, Vice Chancellor delivered inaugural address and explained the various modules covered under Guru Dakshata. Prof.P.K.Srividhya, Registrar delivered special address. She elaborated the code of conduct for the faculty members and elaborated the key result areas and the expected outcome of the FIP.

Module 1: Higher Education and its ecosystem was handled by Prof.S.Velusami, Vice Chancellor, Prof. P.K.Srividhya, Registrar and Prof. E.Ram Ganesh, Dean, Faculty of Arts, Bharathidasan University on 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> June 2023. The recent trends and developments in higher education system were covered.

Module 2: Curriculum designing, Outcome based Learning and Choice Based Credit System was handled by Dr.R.Jayanthi, Director (i/c) IQAC, Dr.B.Mahendramohan, Associate Professor & Head, Department of Management Studies and Dr.A.George, Dean Academic on 22<sup>nd</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> June 2023. The fundamentals of Outcome Based Education, Bloom’s Taxonomy, curriculum framework designing and nuances of CBCS were covered in this session.

Module 3: Teaching, Learning and Assessment was handled by Dr.R.Poonguzhali, Associate Professor, Department of CSE, Dr.D.Umamaheswari, Professor, Department of Commerce and Dr.S.Arumugam, Associate Professor, Department of CSA on 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> June 2023. The methods of assessment used, BRAIN portal usage, teaching and learning techniques and micro teaching methods were covered.

Module 4: Technology for Teaching and assessment of I-generation was conducted by Dr.A.E.Narayanan, Associate Professor, Department of Computer Science Engineering and Dr.Vimal Jerald, St. Joseph College, Trichy on 30<sup>th</sup> June, 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and

4<sup>th</sup> July 2023. The various ICT tools, techniques in e-content development, post production techniques were given hands-on training during the session.

Module 5: Personal Emotional Development and Counseling was handled by Dr.A.Anand Jerard Sebastine, Director CRD and Dr. D.A.Lily Pushpam on 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023. The nuances in handling students were highlighted by the experts during the session.

Module 6: Research, Professional Development and Academic Leadership was handled by Dr.S.Kumaran, Dean, Office of research and development and Dr.P.Balakumar, Director CSSPT. The ethics in research and publications, writing a systematic review article, Literature survey, sourcing of journal in database etc., were covered in these sessions on 8<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> July 2023.

Module 7: Academic Integrity was handled by Dr.Senthamil Kumar, Dean, Faculty of Engineering and Technology and Dr.Sathyapriya J, Associate Professor, Management Studies on 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> July 2023. The Honor codes and honor pledges: need and importance. Case analysis of the Honor codes of some well-established institutions; Ethical conduct of research, Publication ethics, Issues of unauthorized collaboration; Ways of promoting academic integrity, Importance of academic integrity in high quality academic and research outputs were covered in these sessions.

Module 8: Constitutional Values, Human Rights & Fundamental Duties was conducted by Dr.K.Selvakumar, Director KKCPS on 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> July 2023. Human Rights, Fundamental Duties, Implications for the teaching, learning and research and Caste, class and gender in the classroom – examining bias in curriculum, textbooks, classroom processes, research and Role of education in creating a more equal and just society were covered in these sessions.

Module 9: Environmental Consciousness and Sustainable Development Goals was handled by Dr.J.Santosh, Director CEE and Dr.D.Thayalnayaki, Head, Civil Engineering on 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> July 2023. Health and Environment- Good health and wellbeing, Sustainable cities and communities, Responsible consumption and production, Climate action, Life below water, Life on land, Affordable and clean



energy, Clean water and sanitation and Information about initiatives like Swachh Bharat Mission etc. Economy- Decent work and Economic growth, Industry innovation and infrastructure; Role of teachers and higher education institutions in supporting nation to attain SDG, Necessity of SDG for a better society, Current status of India with regard to SDG, whether higher education is suitably aligned, Exploring linkages with constitutional values, Overview of public policy were covered.

Module 10: Strategic Planning and Management was conducted by Dr.KVR Rajandran, Professor, Department of Management Studies, Dr.P.Guru, Director, Centre for Institute Industry Interaction, PMIST on 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> July 2023. Creating and developing a shared vision; Preparing vision/mission document, state and institutional level strategic plan; Defining Goals & Objective; Understanding Planning : Meaning of bottom-up/ decentralized planning, democratized planning and perspective planning; Understanding the perspective of low performing students, students with special needs, gender, caste, minority etc. as well as needs of backward areas in strategic planning were covered.

Assessment was held on 21<sup>st</sup> July 2023. The successfully completed participants were given certificates on Honourable Vice Chancellor, Registrar and Director IQAC.
