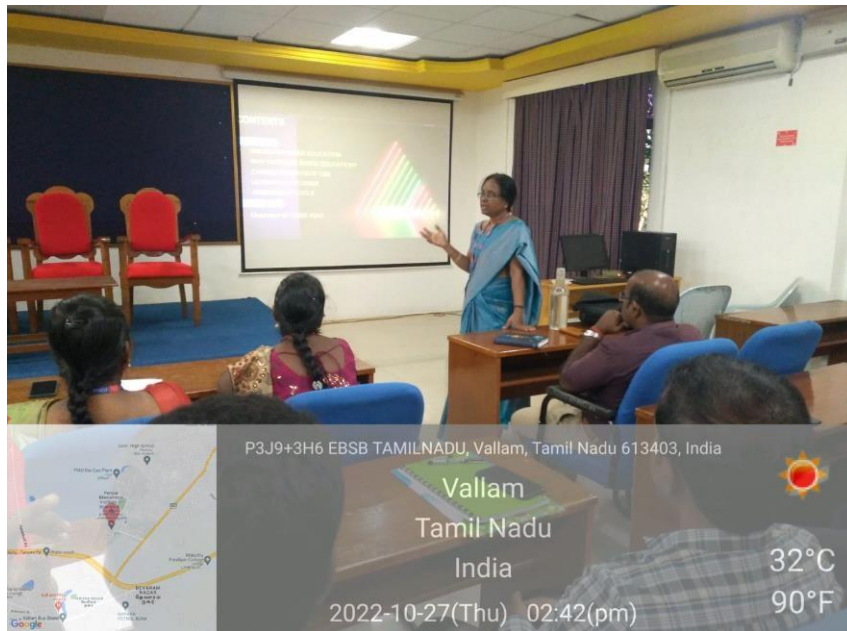

Dr.S.Senthamil Kumar, Dean, FET elaborated the core values of PMIST to the faculty members and highlighted the remarkable achievements and milestones of the Institution.

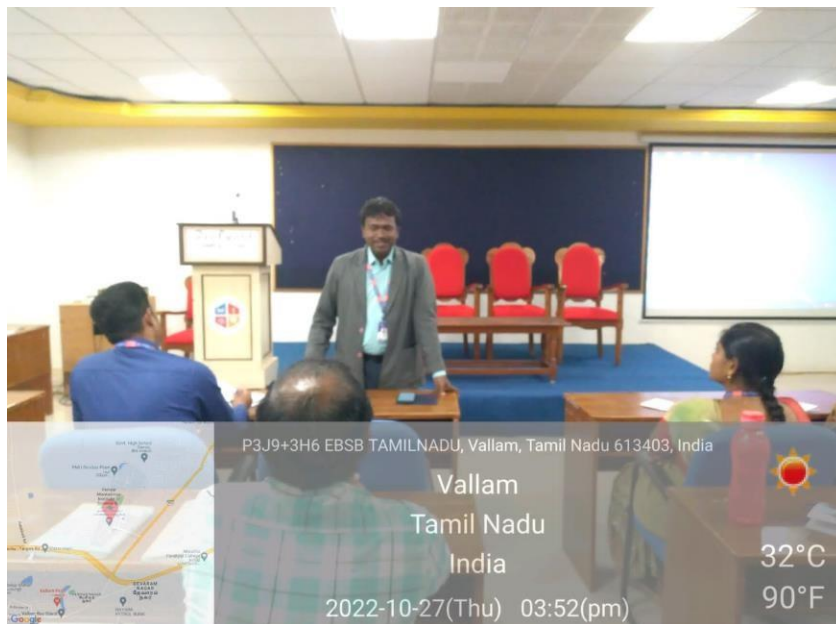

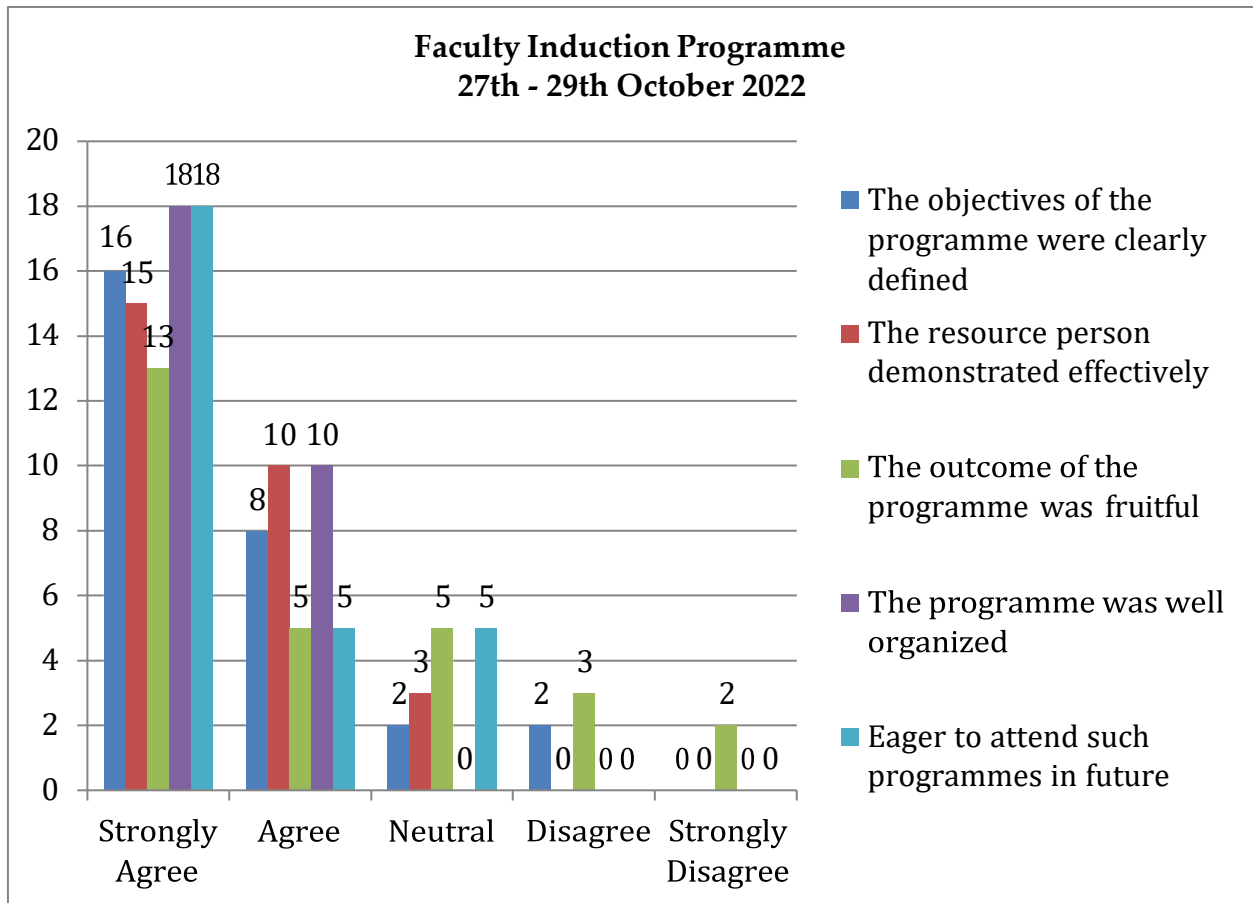
