Overview of the Programme:

Dr.Krishmanurthi, Professor and the Director i/c of the Centre namely Dr.Kalaigina M.Karunanidhi Centre for Political Science of the PMIST invited the participants of the Webinar entitled as Right Based Approaches in Indian Constitution in view of the celebration of Constitution Day 26th November 2021. He moved the ball to celebrate the function with blessing of the Honorable Chancellor Dr.K.Veeramani the senior most members of the family of Periyar Maniammai Institute o Science and Technology. He told that he is the man of incredible activism, unrelenting passion, indefatigable and untiring spirit, a continuous and constant inspiration to the faculty of the PMIST and the legend of Periyarism. He said, that he sowed firstly the seeds of technology for women in the soils of Chennai for the whole of India in the year 1988, one of the greatest missions of Periyar.

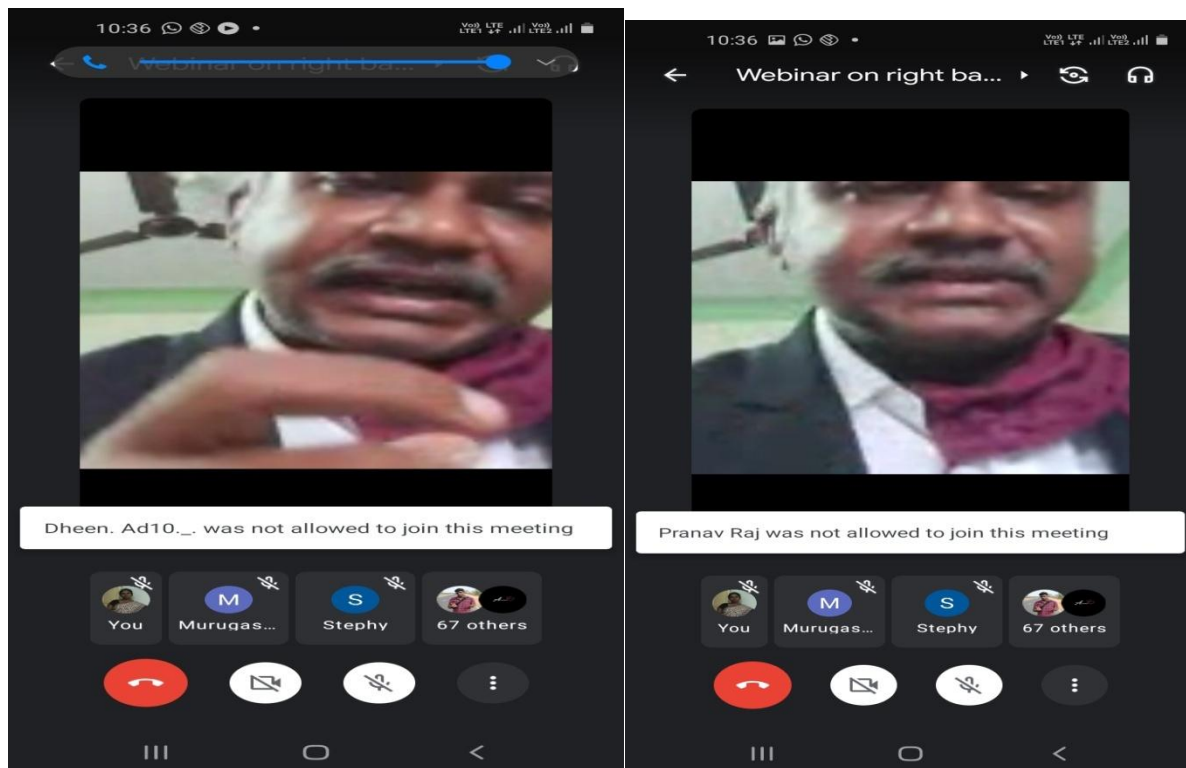

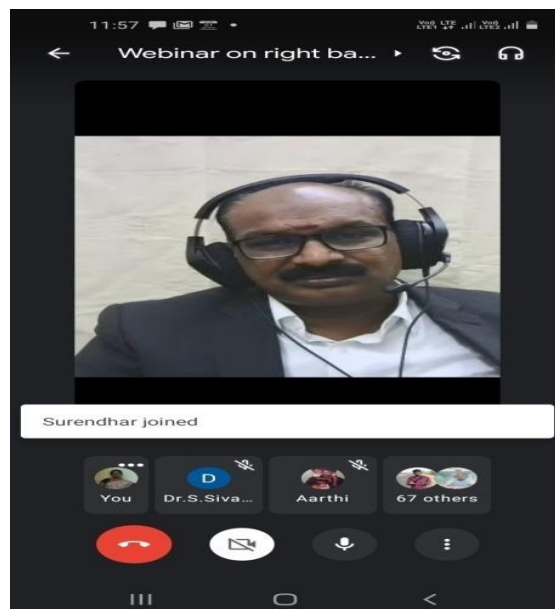

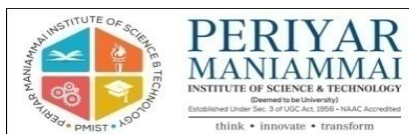

Briefing of the programme:

The programme starts with the introduction of the speaker Dr.R.Krishnamurthi by the Department staff Dr. N. Lenin who also enlightened the importance of celebrating certain days of National and global importance.

Then the speaker Dr.R.Krishnamurthi started delivering his special address on the lead titled as Human Rights Day. First he explained the basic rights and freedoms that belong to every person in the world, from birth until death- These basic rights are based on shared values like dignity, fairness, equality, respect and independence. These values are defined and protected by law.

Virgins worshipped Lord Muruga to get a good husband. Married women worshipped Lord Siva for their husband’s good health and long life. They worshipped Lakshmi for wealth. They also worshipped ‘Kotravai’ the goddess of war to get victory in the war. So there was goddess worship in the Sangam age. But, in the medieval period, he told that the women were not protected properly because of the Muhammadan invasions. They kidnapped beautiful women and he had kept them in their harem. There was no protection and security to women during the period.

Lastly, he spoke about the status of Modern women, whose progress is remarkable in all walks of life. Because of western culture, the life style of the people has been changing. Boys and girls are very fond of western culture. Our tradition and culture have been slowly disappearing .As a result of which there is no protection and security to women and girl children. Hence, their rights at all levels are violated world widely. So, he requested the students to protect our traditions and cultures which are great treasures of India.
