
Objective of the Programme:



Hence, it was decided to analyze the salinity of drinking water to derive some possible solution where it is feasible to study at the Biotechnology and Civil Engineering Department of PMIST. Hence Dr.A. Ashokkumar, who is an Associate Professor of Biotechnology and coordinator of the event addressed Madha Kovil Street people of Pudhukudi to bring sample water from the bore point as well as the point at the storage tank. The collected water samples are stored at 4 °C at the Department of Biotechnology of PMIST for further test performances.

1. SDG 6: Clean Water and Sanitation


The event emphasized the importance of sustainable water management practices, promoting awareness about water conservation and the equitable distribution of water resources.
