AGREEMENT

Whereas Medicare has setup a common facility in accordance with the Bio-medical waste management & Handling rules, 1998 for collection, transport, treatment and disposal of the Bio-medical waste generated by the Health Care Establishments (HCE's - Hospitals, Nursing homes, Clinics, Diagnostic centres, Dental Clinics, Laboratories, etc.,)

Whereas M/S. Dollya, 11th floor, 7th Main Road, Vellore, Tamil Nadu,
Who is Member of the EMA, V.K. (PV), agrees to be a member of
"Medicare" for collection, transportation, treatment and disposal of Bio-medical waste generated
by the HCE's on a user-pay-principle upon mutually agreed terms and conditions mentioned in
this agreement.

Whereas Govt. of Maharashtra, Directorate of Science and Technology, Mumbai, Declares it has Letter No. 109/201/2017/78 dated 10/07/2017, Govt. that Medicare & N.P.C.H. will make periodic inspections regarding the number of beds. If any controversy arises regarding the correctness of the numbers of beds, this will be subject to scrutiny by a joint committee of Medicare & IMA 12.00 PM to decide on the actual bed strength. Then the member will have to pay a penalty for the newly arrived bed strengths, from the date agreement.

Whereas Medicare offices or provide services in M&S 2017-18 Period January to June under pay principle for collection, transport, treatment and disposal at the rate of Rs. 65/- per bed per day with an Deposit Amount equivalent to the payment for 45 days. On full Bed strength basis irrespective of the occupancy for health-care Establishment (members). Charges will be on monthly basis and irrespective of number of days waste collected. Price per day is indicated only for calculating purpose to arrive monthly billing and to accommodate variations i alterations in bed strength and do not relate to number of days serviced. (All Government Taxes extra).

Whereas Govt. of Maharashtra, Directorate of Science and Technology, Mumbai, agrees to joint Medicare, the terms and conditions for this agreement are listed below:

- (1) Member shall get the authorisation from T.N.P.C.B.
- (2) Member shall pay the Documentation Charges of Rs.500/-
- (3) Member shall pay 45 days charges as Deposit Amount to Medicare.
- (4) During agreement period treatment charges and cost of the color coded bags will be revised according to the hike of petroleum products.
- (5) Monthly charges will be minimum of Rs.1500/-

6. Whereas Govt. of Maharashtra, Directorate of Science and Technology, Mumbai, shall segregate the waste in accordance with the MOHFI Ministry of Environment and Forests laid under the Bio Medical Waste (Management and Handling) rules 1998, with latest amendment 2016, under the aegis of Environmental(Protection) ACT 1986.

07. Medicare will Collect Bio. Medical waste regularly and treat the waste as per the regulations. Medicare will not collect any waste that is not segregated or properly.

08. If the member desires, the initial training about segregation and collection of waste in color coded bags shall provided by Medicare free of cost.

09. The member shall collect the segregated wastes in standard color coded bags.

10. Medicare shall distribute standard color coded bags. Bag sizes 13" X 28" = Rs. 5.00/- per bag, 26" X 39" = Rs. 10.00/- per bag, 30" X 36" = Rs. 13.00/- per bag. (Rate per bag Red, Yellow, Blue & Green) excluding GST, applicable as per Government Norms).

11. All the bags shall be sealed and collected at designated point in the hospital mutually agreed by both the parties.

12. Medicare shall collect wastes from the hospitals at times and frequency mutually and reasonably agreed by both parties.

13. In case Medicare fails to collect waste within 24 hours of previous collecting the member shall inform to Medicare and the same shall be cleared within the next 24 hours.

14. Medicare shall be liable for any violation under the Bio-medical waste (Management & Handling) rules, 1998 from the time the waste is handed over to Medicare.

15. Medicare shall meet all the rules and regulations stipulated by the Tatyasaheb Patilawade Control Board.

16. All Payments shall be drawn in favour of "Medicare Enviro Systems" in the form of Demand draft or Cheque, payable at Thane.

17. The DD or Cheque should reach Medicare's Thane office on or before 5th of every month without fail.



18. Payments made after 5th, shall attract a penalty of Rs.30/- per day.
19. Returned Cheque shall be charged Rs.200/- extra in addition to the actual bank charges.
20. Medicare shall stop services if payments are not received by 15th of the month and the matter will be informed to the T.N.P.C.B. or non co-operation.
21. If the Member stops the services of Medicare without proper intimation, then this Agreement will get automatically cancelled and the matter will be informed to TNPB for canceling the BMW Authorization given to the Health Care Establishment.
22. Any charges of robes, diapers, push chair, ie charges etc., will be sorted out by a joint committee of Medicare and IMA.....
23. If it is a Diagnostics centre, liquid waste should be disposed by the member itself.
24. Renewal of agreement will be made only after settlement full payment of previous bills.
25. Medicare Enviro Systems is authorized by TNPB (Authorization No. BNEW-0004) dated 21.05.2003 to transport, Collect, Treat and End Disposal of Bio-Medical Waste from 9 Districts (Trichy, Thanjavur, Pudukkottai, Sivagangai, Nagapattinam, Tiruvarur, Ariyalur and Perambalur Districts)
26. Both the Parties MEDICARE & MEMBER will have an individual Original Agreement for their future reference.

Whereas Medicare undertakes to collect, transport, treat and dispose the Bio-medical waste, Member shall undertake to adhere to this contract of services by Medicare for minimum period of Five years and the Agreement should be renewed immediately.
