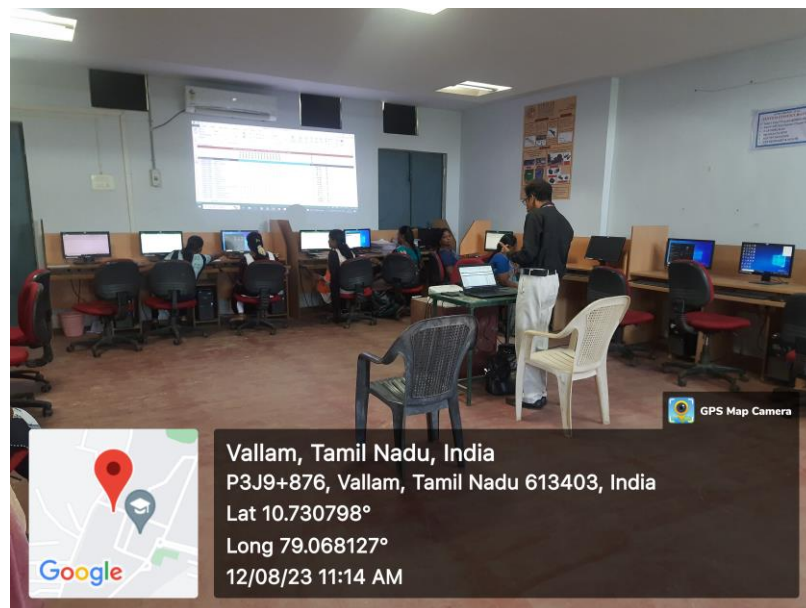

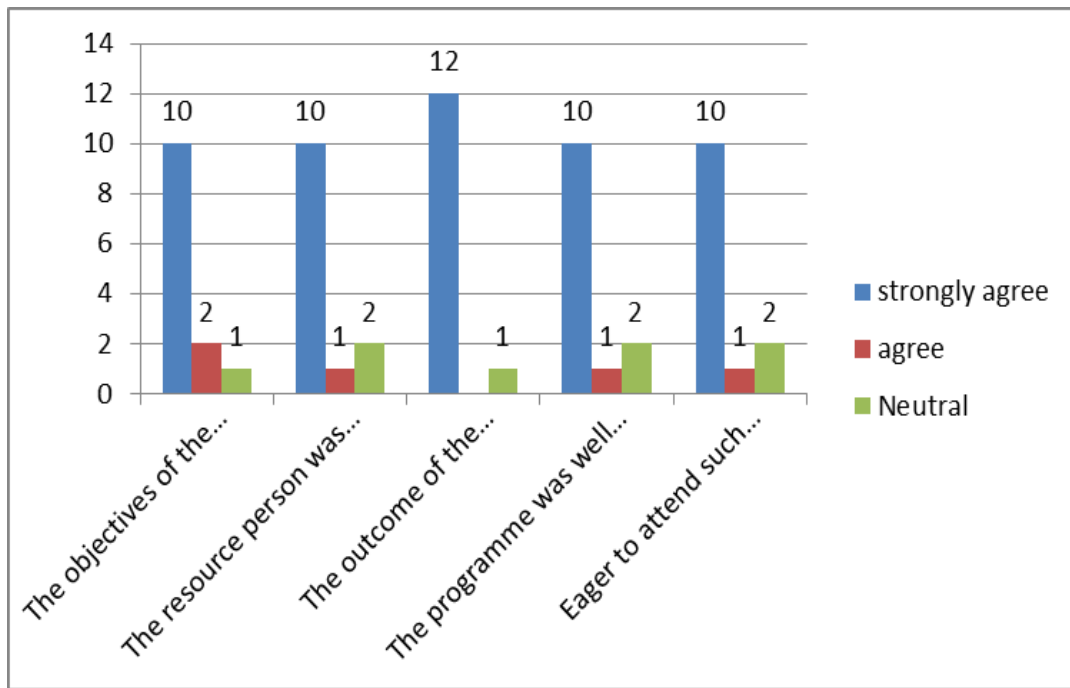

Faculty Development Programme on Outcome Based Education

(23.08.2023 to 29.08.2023)

The department of Commerce has organized Faculty Development Programme on "Outcome Based Education" from 23.08.2023 to 29.08.2023. The commerce department faculties have attended the programme. The resource persons are Dr.N.Jayanthi, Head, Commerce department, Dr.D.Umamameshwari, Professor and Dr.S.Prabhu, Asst. Professor, Department of Commerce.

On first day, first session of the programme, Dr.N.Jayanthi has delivered lecture on Fundamentals of OBE. She explained before understanding the concept of OBE, we must understand why there's a need for an **outcome based education system**. What are the factors that have made OBE, the most "**sensible**" way of learning in the current situation?. The differences between traditional educational system and OBE system were explained. Second session has been taken by Dr.D.Ummaheswari. She has narrated importance of revised Bloom's taxonomy. She added that Bloom's Taxonomy can help educators map learning within a single lesson or even a whole course. Using the taxonomy as a guide, trainers can identify clear instructional goals corresponding to each taxonomy level and create plans to achieve them. By setting achievable objectives for learners, instructors make them more active and responsible for their education. The new learning stages are **Remember, Understand, Apply, Analyze, Evaluate** and **Create**.

The second day of first session was taken by Dr.N.Jayanthi and explained how to frame Course outcomes. She explained that Course Outcomes are the statements that help the learners to understand the reason for pursuing the course and helps to identify what he will be able to do at the end of the course. A Course outcome should define the knowledge, skills, the application of the knowledge and the skills the learner has acquired which he is able to demonstrate as the result of pursuing the course. The second session was handled by Dr.D.Ummaheswari. She has delivered preparation of Course plan. She has explained with suitable examples.

Dr.S.Prabhu has explained course process documentation on third day. He has explained how to conduct course committee meeting and follow up action. Dr.Jayanthi delivered lecture on CO PO mapping and how to attain COs and POs.

On fourth day Dr.N.Jayanthi has delivered lecture on How to setting Question paper and how the questions aligned with course outcomes and bloom's taxonomy. Dr.S.Prabhu has explained Programme Articulation Mapping.

Dr.S.Prabhu has explained to Measure Course Outcome Attainments. He has given practical exposure. Dr.D.Umamaheswari has given talk on Basics of Continuous Quality Improvement. She added that essentials of CQI, how to implement CQI and strategies to attain CQI.

On Sixth day, D.N.Jayanthi has given hands on training on framing course outcomes and setting question papers. Dr.D.Umamaheswari has delivered lecture on Measuring Continuous Quality Improvement. Totally 27 faculty members from the department of commerce, languages and mathematics were attended and benefited.

- Participants acquired the skills to design question papers that are aligned with course outcomes and Bloom's Taxonomy.
- Practical sessions on setting questions ensured that participants could apply theoretical knowledge to create assessments that accurately evaluate learning outcomes.
- Faculty members were introduced to the concept of CQI and its significance in maintaining and enhancing educational quality.
- The programme enabled participants to map Course Outcomes (COs) to Programme Outcomes (POs) effectively.
- Practical sessions provided exposure to tools and techniques for assessing outcome attainment and aligning these with programme goals.

The FDP empowered participants to transition from traditional teaching methods to an outcome-based approach, fostering a learner-centric educational environment. By equipping faculty members with the tools and strategies for OBE implementation, the programme ensured a holistic enhancement of teaching, assessment, and curriculum design practices. These outcomes will contribute significantly to improving the overall quality of education and aligning it with global standards.

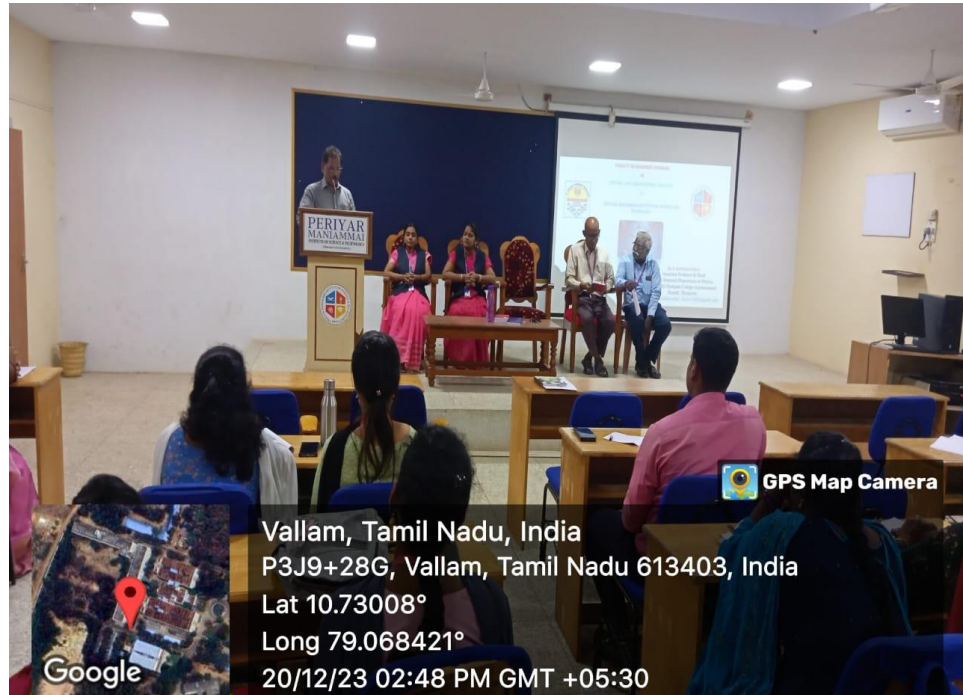

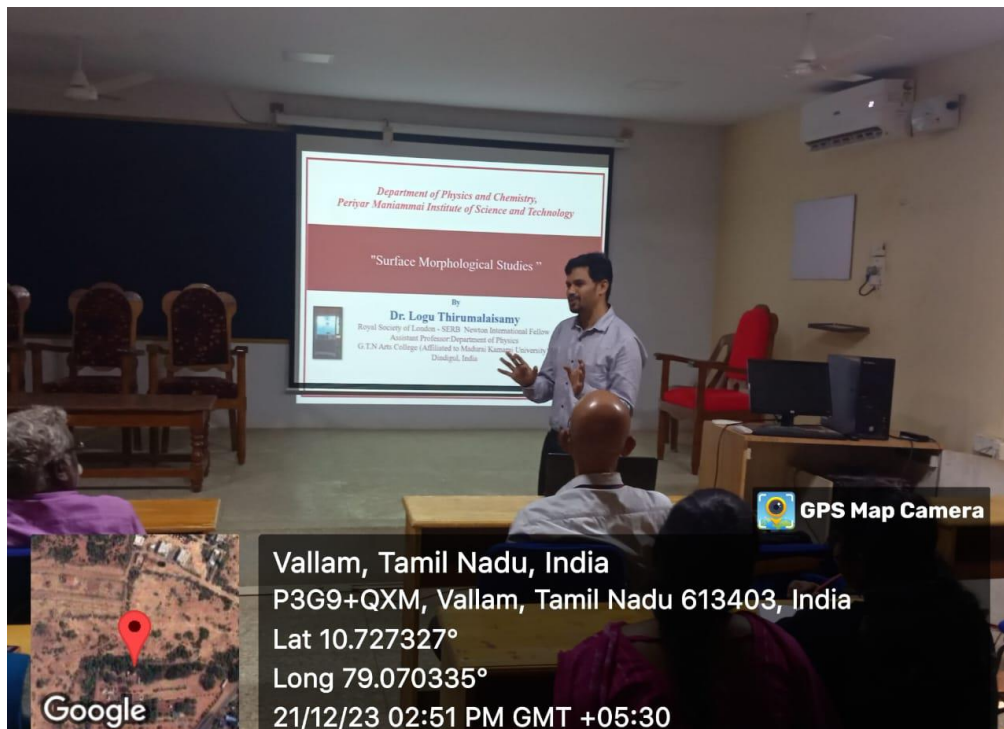

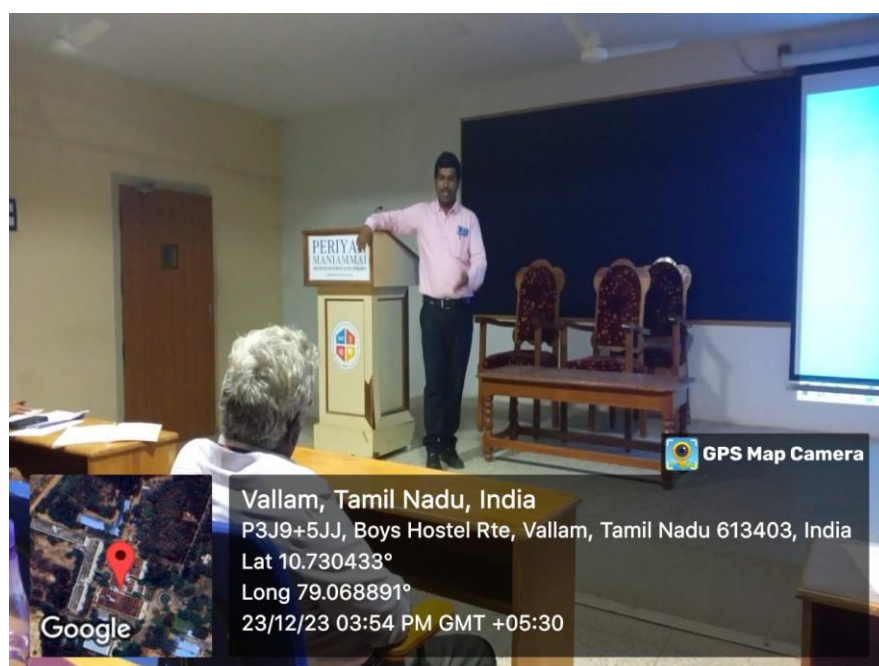
