To avail the above scholarship, the research scholar should satisfy the following conditions;

- Scholar should maintain a **Research Diary** from the first day of their admission. In that diary, it is instructed to record the following: discussion, research gap, results, progress, journals referred and studied / presentation in any conference, etc. This should be duly signed by the concerned supervisor. This diary is the most important document for the verification (photocopy of the pages should be scanned and submitted to RAC through proper channels at the end of every month).
- For Full time Research Scholars, at the end of every semester, tuition fee paid by the scholar will be refunded / provided that scholar publish at least one scientific publication in a year in Scopus / Web of Science / SCI indexed journals.
- For internal part-time Research Scholars, at the end of every semester, 50 % of tuition fee paid by the scholar will be refunded / provided that scholar publish at least one scientific publication in a year in Scopus / Web of Science / SCI indexed journals.
- In the first semester, at least one paper presentation in an International conference or one review paper in Scopus / Web of Science / SCI indexed journals to receive the scholarship.
- Full time Research Scholars, every month the progress report and attendance (minimum 80% are required; medical leave or any other emergency leave can be availed with the permission of HoD and Dean) must be submitted to the office of the Dean Research through proper channel (Research Supervisor, HoD and Dean Concerned) to obtain the scholarship. Based on the progress and the Research Advisory Committee's recommendations, scholarship will be provided.

- Full time scholars are encouraged to apply for any Central / State Government scholarship like CSIR-SRF etc. after getting prior permission through proper channel. If the scholar obtains the grant, the PMIST scholarship will not be provided.
- Research Scholar should work along with the Research Supervisor to submit research proposals for the funding agencies, two Conferences in the National / International level in their respective research thrust areas per year, establish facility like indigenous lab / simulation / Models or any other facility at PMIST.
- Research Scholar are encouraged to work in consultancy projects (remuneration can be availed as per PMIST rules and regulations) and should attempt to find a problem from the nearby industry and to work out in finding possible solutions
- Once in six months the Research Advisory Committee will review the progress and decide the scholarship renewal.
- Scholarship will be provided only for three years for full time research scholars / four years for internal part-time research scholars.
- In case, if the scholar discontinues the Ph.D. programmes; he / she should reimburse one semester tuition fee.
- In this context it is submitted for your kind perusal and approval for providing scholarship for the full-time research scholars and management scholarship for internal part-time research scholars admitted from the academic year 2021-22 onwards.

As per the suggestions given by the Examination Advisory Committee, the following proposals are recommended:

1. To introduce flexible question paper pattern for Ph.D. course work subjects from the year 2022 onwards.
One of the criteria of **OBE** system is to have flexibility in the question paper pattern. Accordingly it is proposed to introduce the above system for Ph.D. students.
2. In respect of End Semester Examination, **20%** of the subjects answer scripts (department wise) to be valued by external experts.
As opined by the Examination Advisory Committee, it is proposed to involve external experts partially in evaluation process.
3. To insist that the students appearing for FAST TRACK examinations should have necessarily appeared in the regular End Semester Examinations and absent candidates are not eligible to write the Fast Track examinations.
4. At least one MOOC course is to be opted by PG students from the year 2022 even semester onwards, as per the recommendation of UGC / AICTE.
5. To pay remuneration, TA & DA to the external subject experts as per Institute Norms.

Dr. S. Sangeetha, External Member enquired how the 20% external evaluation is planned.

The Controller of Examinations replied that, the external evaluator will be choosing 4 papers randomly among 20 answer scripts.
